The Gabi Analytics Platform (the platform used by health care professionals) is owned by Gabi SmartCare SA (together with its affiliates - "Gabi SmartCare", "we" or "us"), whose head office is located at 1435 Mont-Saint-Guibert, Rue Emile Francqui 6, Belgium VAT (BE) 0683.446.756 (www.gabismartcare.com).

We use certain web monitoring and tracking technologies, such as cookies, beacons, pixels, tags, and scripts (collectively, "Cookies") to provide, maintain, and improve our website, platform and services (collectively, the "Services"), to optimize our offerings and marketing activities, and to provide our visitors ("you" or "your") with a better experience (for example, in order to track your preferences, to better secure our Services, to identify technical issues, and to monitor and improve the overall performance of our Services).

1. Role and responsibilities

Certain data protection laws and regulations, such as the EU General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR") and the California Consumer Privacy Act ("CCPA"), typically distinguish between two main roles for parties processing personal data: the "Data Controller" (or under the CCPA, "business"), who determines the purposes and means of processing; and the "Data Processor" (or under the CCPA, "service provider"), who processes the data on behalf of the Data Controller.

We act as Data Controller when processing your personal data via cookies. More information about how we process your personal data may be found in our Privacy Policy.

In this Cookies Policy, "personal data" and "data controller" have the meaning of the GDPR (and any national act and/or decree implementing it), as well as any other applicable data protection legislation (together, the "Applicable Law").

2. Use of Cookies

2.1 What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are stored through the browser on your computer or mobile device (e.g., Google Chrome or Safari) when you visit our Platform. They are used to enable our Platform to function or to provide us information about your use of our Services.

Part of the cookies are deleted when you close your browser. These are known as session cookies. Others remain on your computer or electronic device until they expire or you delete them from your cache. These are known as persistent cookies and enable us to remember information about you as a returning visitor.

2.2 How do we use cookies?

There is one type of Cookies used on our Platform:

Essential & Functional Cookies: Essential and Functional Cookies are necessary for the Website and Platform to function properly, and cannot be disabled. These are cookies that are needed for (i) technical purposes, such as allowing the use of our Website and Platform, and facilitate electronic communications (i.e. keep track of information about a user session, determining which options or pages to display) and for (ii) disclaimer purposes, such as recording when you have seen a policy or provided your consent. These cookies do not store information about you that will be used for other purposes.

2.3 How can you reject or remove cookies

Except for essential and functional cookies, your consent is needed in order for the cookies to be stored in your computer. Your consent has been obtained when you accept the privacy policy when you enter our Platform for the first time.

If you wish to remove cookies set by this Platform from your browser, you may withdraw your consent at any time via your profile in the Platform. You may also delete them at any time. The instructions for removing cookies from your computer or electronic device depend on the operating system and web browser you use. Please note that rejecting or removing certain Cookies may result in inadequate Services. You can opt-out of each Cookie category (except Essential & Functional Cookies) by clicking the "Cookie Settings" button in your Profile and changing your settings accordingly.

2.4 Cookies duration

There are two main types of cookies: persistent cookies and session cookies.

Session Cookies are temporary cookies that are stored in your browser while you are navigating the website. Once you closes your browser, session cookies are deleted. Hence, these cookies are used to store information that is required only for the duration of your session, such as items in a shopping cart, login credentials, or the contents of a form that you are filling out.

Persistent Cookies are permanent cookies that are stored on your computer or mobile device even after the browser is closed. They have an expiration date of maximum 12 months. Persistent cookies are used to remember your preferences, login credentials, and other information that you have provided to a website. This information can be used to personalize your experience and make it easier for you to navigate the website.
